





What history do you have with watching this goofy duo's original adventures?

I was 15 at the time, and I remember watching them as part of a Saturday morning group of cartoons. I always thought they were silly fun, nothing ever too heavy, and they felt a lot like H-B's version of Batman with a dog sidekick that happens to be a robot. When I was offered this series from Dynamite, I had to go back and watch the cartoons again, and yeah, they were not the deepest story-wise, but there was a joy that the two main characters had and a connection between them that I thought would be a good story element to explore. Remember, our memories of things when we were young stay with us forever!

The show originally kicked off with Dynomutt leading the way in both the title and being more of the focus in the stories, although the second season switched to the shared title that our series is also using. What is your approach in writing the

I can relate more to Blue Falcon, and he is front and center in the story with Dynomutt starting off as a real dog rather than the mechanical mutt we see in the cartoons. This is not the origin of Blue Falcon, but a story about a man and his dog and their connection throughout a major event in both their lives — things happen that cause Radley to depend on the technology he created to help him out of his situation. By the end of the book, it becomes more 50/50 for both characters, but number one for me in writing this series is that it has to be fun — well, my version of fun anyway. I will say that some of it is much darker than people might remember, but it makes sense to the characters. I updated the world around them a bit for sure.

It sounds like you're taking a whole new spin on the world of Big City and the origins of Radley Crown and his faithful canine companion, which the original show barely touched on. How would you compare the tone you're going for with the more lighthearted original cartoon?

My take is not lighthearted, story-wise, the future ahead of him! I am not always but it has its moments where fun and humor are part of their lives, like they are for anyone, no matter how heavy things get. This series is all about relationships — the main one involving our characters, the love life of Radley Crown, and even the villain's relationship with the world. I always try to answer two simple questions with a new series: What do the characters want, and what do they fear? The answers are all here within their adventure together. think this book will appeal to the diehard Dynomutt audience as well as anyone giving it a shot for the first time.

Pasquale Qualano is joining you for this series as your artistic companion in crimefighting. How is the collaboration going, and what's it been like seeing his pen bring your action-packed scripts to the page?

I always find it difficult to work with someone I haven't worked with before, and the cool part of diving right into this with Pasquale is that I am getting to watch him not only nail it, but also seeing how he gets better with each issue. His evolution in this book is really fun to watch as he starts to make Big City and its inhabitants live and breathe on the page. He has quite

the easiest writer to deal with, I know, and he is doing a terrific job. Just wait till you see issue #3 — so impressive!

The Blue Falcon & Dynomutt were also famous for initially sharing a programming block with Scooby-Doo and his gang, and even featuring in multiple crossover episodes. Do you think that famous crew could fit into the vision you've built up for this series?

I think it's an easy fit, especially with the world we are setting up in this series. Those kids and their Mystery Machine would fit right into Big City and the things going down in it! Radly is guite the businessman and inventor, so I think a trip investigating an insurance scam involving a crooked Big City politician haunting city hall would be a no-brainer. I also think Scooby and Dynomutt would be sniffing butts and getting along in no time.



SUPERSTAR SOO LEE SHARES HER VISION OF THE WIZARD OF OZ

BRINGING THE MASTERPIECE MOVIE TO THE GRAPHIC NOVEL PAGE

Soo, you were tasked with the daunt- Maleficent, in which you tackled both ing role of adapting and reinterpreting one of the most iconic stories in modern media. How did you even start the process of organizing your approach for this book? And how did you feel about the pressure in handling this story?

Because this is a movie adaptation, the structure was there already and I used that for the beat of the storyline for the graphic novel. I wanted to be true to the story while still allowing for mv visuals and style to show my interpretation of the movie. It's my love letter to the story.

This brand-new graphic novel is adapted from the beloved film, which is celebrating over 85 incredible years of both touching the hearts of fans and influencing filmmaking. What history and feelings do you have towards the film, and did you pull key inspiration from any other iterations of the story or outside sources?

I went back and watched the movie for inspiration. I think one of the most important themes of the story, which I didn't appreciate when I was younger, and their loyalty in response to her may not have known about! kindness.

I'm not reinventing the wheel, but I'm adding my interpretation to the history of this legendary story. So I wanted to make sure I invested more time in certain scenes between the crew to shine light on their relationship.

The diehard Dynamite faithful know that you are a multitalented creator. Years back you drew a few titles with us, and then recently fans got the chance to experience your writing skills on series like ThunderCats: Cheetara. One of your recent masterpieces has been Disney Villains:

the writing and the art, as you are doing here on The Wizard of Oz. What unique challenges and rewarding experiences does both writing and drawing a story pose, especially on a book of this length?

The pacing was the trickiest part of retelling this story. The movie has a set timeline of storytelling, but I was allowed more pages to indulge in and take my time on certain scenes, so I took advantage of the medium without trying to muddy the story. I wanted to really emphasize the crew's relationship and the emotions of the scenes between the characters.

Fans of the film will recognize all the can't-miss story beats in your tvision of The Wizard of Oz, but this isn't a strict frame-by-frame translation from the screen to the page. Without spoiling too much, are there some interesting minor twists or elements seen in your tale that you could tease us about?

THE STITCH CREW DISCUSS THEIR TAKE ON THE **CHAOTIC BLUE FURBALL!**

Connor and James, welcome to the world away when I first watched the film, beof Stitch! What memories and feelings did you have towards the franchise and its characters, prior to jumping into this new series?

CR: This was a real thrill for both of us, to get to play in this particular sandbox. I saw Lilo & Stitch the day it was released in theaters and loved it, just so funny and exciting and also very sweet. And Stitch has become one of the most iconic characters in the entire Disney canon. He's everywhere.

J3: I wasn't super familiar with Stitch beyond knowing "Hawaiian Roller Coaster Ride" was a bop. I was genuinely blown leros and The Three Little Pigs.

cause what do you mean there's a Disney movie with the premise, "What if your best friend was a furry little mischievous alien unlearning diabolically evil programming?" That's bonkers! Where have l been?

This latest series is titled Stitch, but we'd love to know which other beloved characters from the original film may be popping up in your stories.

CR: The core of this series is really a trio: Jumba, Pleakley, and Stitch. There is such a rich tradition of Disney trios, from Mickey, Donald, and Goofy to The Three CabalJ3: Don't forget the Sanderson Sisters!

CR: So many trios! And we also bring back a lot of other characters in smaller ways.

J3: We're squeezing Cobra Bubbles into as many issues as we possibly can. He's a lumbering giant with a deep booming voice that we hope will be as fun for the reader to imagine as it was for us to write. The live-action trailer dropping led to us writing Ombit into an issue, because "he took the red one" was iconic in 2002 and remains iconic now.

Now that we know a bit about who's showing up, let's look at the plot. This series centers around a mission undertaken by Dr. Jumba. What drew you to focus on him as the key thread for your initial story? And beyond being his usual forceof-nature self, how does Stitch factor into this adventure?

CR: In some ways Jumba and Pleakley are a double act, with Stitch inserting himself into their dynamic because he can't resist the temptation to play around with whatever Jumba is working on. Jumba is a genius, but he invented something that is smarter than he is, and he is forever paying the price for that! It's almost like how parents, deep down, want their kids to be smarter and do better than they did, but then when faced with that reality, it can often be overwhelming!

J3: Jumba's motivations in the comic are perfectly summed up in the first movie: the Grand Councilwoman calls him an "idiot scientist," to which he responds, "I prefer to be called evil genius!" He deeply desires to be acknowledged for his malfeasance, but instead gets bupkis. He won't let that stop him, though! His devious drive to experiment 625 times before finally getting it "right" - in heavy quotes - is the engine for the relentless sci-fi hijinks in the series.

The two of you are co-writing this comic – how does the collaboration process work for each of you?

CR: James and I met doing improv and sketch comedy at the Upright Citizens Brigade Theatre in NYC, and we instantly liked each other. James has such a great brain for comedy, and I just have so much fun coming up with ideas with him. For this series, we just started coming up with as many weird ideas as we could - we were encouraged to go a little crazy with it. And then we sort of treat it like a road trip, where you take turns driving and

navigating. Basically, for the actual writing part, one of us will do the main draft and then the other one will go through and try to make it even better, and we go back and forth until we are satisfied with it. I feel like James's drafts don't really need much fixing, so what I contribute is like comedic seasoning. James has to do a lot more clean-up on what I write, because I'm newer at this process and I feel like my first drafts are a real mess. But we get there by the time we submit a script for approval!

J3: Connor does a great job, I don't know what he's talking about.

The wonderful Italian artist Greta Xella is joining you to illustrate the series. How has it been working with her and seeing her translate your scripts to the page?

CR: As of this moment, we haven't seen any of the art for these stories yet! But I'm very excited to see what Greta comes up with, because everything I've seen of her work has been fantastic.

J3: Nate shared with us Greta's character sketches when we signed on, and even at that early stage they were such vibrant depictions. She has a strong grasp of these characters' personalities and gives them so much life. Her Stitch especially is cosmically delightful. And her portfolio has some incredibly striking fantasy art, so we're very excited to see this mad sci-fi epic we wrote go from page to panel with someone of her caliber.
